CLASS PREREQUISITES – Dogs must be:

- At least 6 months of age.
- Current on vaccinations (please provide proof with your registration). We want everyone healthy and happy.
- Leashed and under the control of an owner at all times.
- Dog must be non-reactive to other dogs and people (extreme fear or aggression)
- Owner/handler must be able to stand and move around for up to 30 minutes
- Owner/handler must be able to walk briskly

Our instructors reserve the right to excuse a dog that shows aggression to people or other dogs.

Additionally, we encourage all dogs to be spayed or neutered and require all dogs be up-to-date on the following vaccinations (**proof of vaccinations from your veterinarian is required prior to the first class**):

- Distemper/Parvo Combination
- Rabies
- Bordetella
